A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH EATON AND ASSOCIATES TO SERVE AS THE CITY OF BURLINGAME'S INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES PROVIDER FOR TWO ADDITIONAL YEARS, WITH A NOT-TO-EXCEED LIMIT OF \$1.9 MILLION

WHEREAS, in May 2022, the City of Burlingame entered into a three-year agreement with Eaton and Associates for a term of June 1, 2022, through June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, both the City of Burlingame and Eaton and Associates have enjoyed a productive partnership and desire to continue the current arrangement for two additional years and expand the scope of work to include an add-on Managed Security Operation Center (SOC); and

WHEREAS, the MOC will ensure the City can continue to operate a secure and up-todate IT environment and enhance the City's security by providing 24/7 threat monitoring, detection, and response to cyber threats.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Burlingame hereby approves an amendment to the agreement with Eaton and Associates in substantial form and compliance with Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein to allow Eaton and Associates to serve as the City's information technology services provider for two additional years, to include a Managed SOC in the scope of work, and to revise the agreement's not-to-exceed amount to be \$1.9 million.
