Subject: Adoption of a Resolution Approving the City of Burlingame Salary Schedule

- Casual Employees, Effective June 30, 2025

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the City of Burlingame pay rates and ranges for Casual Employees (salary schedule) effective June 30, 2025.

BACKGROUND

The Salary Schedule – Casual contains part-time and seasonal classifications that are unrepresented. The City Council last updated the Casual Salary Schedule in December 2024 (Resolution No. 147-2024).

DISCUSSION

On June 30, 2025, the AFSCME Administrative and AFSCME Maintenance bargaining groups will receive their contractual cost-of-living increase. To maintain internal equity and mitigate compaction issues, Human Resources proposes increasing several positions listed in the Salary Schedule - Casual by 4%, the same cost-of-living adjustment that the AFSCME Administrative and AFSCME Maintenance bargaining units will receive. The positions proposed for the salary increase include the following.
