Subject: Discussion of Regulations Regarding Micromobility Devices

## **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the City Council receive the staff report regarding micromobility devices and provide direction regarding possible regulations.

# **BACKGROUND**

At the May 6, 2024 City Council meeting, Mayor Colson and Councilmember Pappajohn requested a Future Agenda item regarding regulations governing micromobility devices. This presentation is in response to that request.

### **DISCUSSION**

Micromobility devices are defined by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) as "[a]ny small, low-speed, human or electric-powered transportation device, including bicycles, scooters, electric-assist bicycles (e-bikes), electric scooters (e-scooters), and other small, lightweight, wheeled conveyances." These devices can be powered manually, by electric motor, or through a combination of both. Some micromobility devices are currently regulated by the state Vehicle Code and/or the Burlingame Municipal Code.
