**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AUTHORIZING  
THE MAYOR TO SEND A LETTER TO THE NATIONAL TRUST FOR HISTORIC  
PRESERVATION IN SUPPORT OF THE 220 PARK ROAD AND TOWN SQUARE  
PRESERVATION AWARD APPLICATION**

**WHEREAS**, for the last 75 years, the National Trust for Historic Preservation has led the movement to save America's historic places; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to honor the places saved and work done in preservation, the Richard H. Driehaus Foundation National Preservation Award recognizes and celebrates the "best of the best" in preservation projects that highlight cutting-edge preservation approaches or technologies; and

**WHEREAS**, former Mayor Cathy Baylock, Councilmember Colson, and Sares Regis are jointly working on submitting 220 Park Road and the Town Square for a Richard H. Driehaus Foundation National Preservation Award. According to the National Trust; and

**WHEREAS**, the award application requires three letters of support, and the team is requesting letters from the City of Burlingame, the Burlingame/SFO Chamber of Commerce, and the Burlingame Historical Society.
