WHEREAS, staff has negotiated a scope of professional services agreement with Mott MacDonald in the amount of \$443,386; and

WHEREAS, there are adequate funds available in the Capital Improvement Program to complete the design of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the CITY COUNCIL of the City of Burlingame, California, which FINDS, ORDERS and DETERMINES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The public interest and convenience require execution of the Professional Services Agreement cited in the title above.
