





### POTENTIAL HIGHLAND AVENUE CROSS SECTIONS IN THIS OPTION




**BUFFERED BIKE LANES | ON-STREET PARKING ON ONE SIDE**




**SHARED BIKE/CAR LANES | ON-STREET PARKING ON BOTH SIDES**









# Feedback From Initial Community Outreach

- Lanes on California Drive are narrow.
- Lots of auto businesses on California park the vehicles being maintained on the sidewalk, bike lanes on Highland would reduce that.
