Easton Branch Library History and Highlights May 2025

First, a little Easton Library history...

- The **Easton Branch Library opened in 1942**, in the former clubhouse of the North Burlingame Women's Club. When it opened, there were 3,000 books in the library, and **today there are over 17,000 items.**
- The Easton Branch was a full-service library from the 1950's through the mid 1970's, but in 1978,
 Proposition 13 nearly closed Easton. Fortunately, a group of citizens (including Kris Cannon!) came to the rescue, and helped keep Easton open with reduced hours.
- In **2001**, the City Council agreed to a **renovation plan for Easton**, to improve the **condition** and **seismic safety** of the building, and to provide **accessibility** for disabled patrons.
- Easton closed for renovation in 2003 and reopened in October 2004 as a completely new space, highlighting popular materials, audio-visual items, and a large children's collection. Easton's hours were also increased to 30 hours per week: Monday through Thursday 2-8 pm, and Friday & Saturday 2-5 pm.

And now, some recent activity and upcoming events:

- Easton is always a **popular spot after school**, since **four schools** -- Our Lady of Angels School (across the street), Lincoln School, Roosevelt School, and Hoover School -- are all **within walking distance**.
- We have **two Storytimes per week** at Easton -- **Toddler Storytime** on Tuesday mornings (about 80 patrons each week), and **Bedtime Storytime** on Wednesday evenings (about 40 patrons each week).
- Easton is a perfect location for in-person class visits, with students from local schools walking to Easton for a visit with a Children's Librarian. The Children's Librarians have regular class visits at Easton with students from OLA, Lincoln, Roosevelt, and Hoover Schools.
- The major Children's Department programming offered at the Main Library such as Summer Learning, Winter Reading, and Poetry Month for elementary school-age children are all offered at Easton as well.
- We just completed a very successful Poetry Month at Easton in April, with 237 children bringing in an original poem that they had written, and choosing a free book of poetry to keep.
- And we're just starting our annual Summer Reading Program, which will run through August 15th at both Main and Easton. We'll be having an Easton Summer Reading Kickoff Celebration on Easton's front porch on Monday, June 2 at 6:00 pm!

In summary...

The Easton Branch Library continues to be a "treasured neighborhood library" for patrons of all ages, and many patrons walk from their nearby homes to enjoy this beautiful gem in north Burlingame!
