Subject: Informational Overview of the City's Athletic Fields

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Commission review the informational overview of the City's athletic fields to better understand the City's facilities and their current uses.

BACKGROUND

The purpose of the presentation is to summarize the locations of each field, primary field uses, availability of field lighting, and designated off-leash areas for the new commissioners and to provide a refresher for the veteran commissioners. The overview does not relate to the field policy, which will be discussed at a later date.

DISCUSSION

The City currently maintains six (6) parks with athletic fields available for sports programming, Recreation Division programming, rentals, and drop-in use. They are Bayside Park, Murray Park, Ray Park, Cuernavaca Park, Village Park, and Washington Park. The Burlingame School District (BSD) maintains two (2) fields, BIS and Franklin.

The City and the BSD maintain a joint-use agreement for the athletic fields at BIS and Franklin, both of which are owned and maintained by the BSD. Per the agreement, the City will contribute half of the cost of replacing the resilient turf when it is time to replace it. While BPRD does not maintain these fields, the Department is responsible for coordinating and managing all field reservations at these locations.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact from the presentation.




