Background

• Burlingame applied for and received Measure A & W funding for the California Drive Class I Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement Project. This project consists of the construction of 0.4 miles of a Class I shared use bicycle and pedestrian path along California Drive, between Oak Grove Avenue and Burlingame Avenue. This project will enhance north/south connectivity and closing one of the major gaps in the "backbone" of the San Mateo County bicycle network. Additionally it will enhance the safety, comfort, and attractiveness for usersof all ages and abilities.

• Project Amount \$1,800,000






