**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AUTHORIZING  
THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN UNITED AGAINST HATE WEEK**

**WHEREAS**, United Against Hate Week was started by the Mayor of Berkeley in 2017 and is a call for seven days of local civic action by people in every Bay Area community to stop the "hate and the implicit biases that are a threat to the safety and civility of our neighborhoods, towns and cities;" and

**WHEREAS**, this year, United Against Hate Week will be held November 17-23; and

**WHEREAS**, there is widespread support in the East Bay for United Against Hate Week, and the sponsors are now seeking to widen its reach by asking communities in San Mateo County to adopt resolutions of support, post signs, and host events; and

**WHEREAS**, in July 2017, the City Council adopted a resolution affirming the City's commitment to diversity and inclusion, and that resolution is in line with the goals of United Against Hate Week.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Burlingame supports United Against Hate Week.
