RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council make appointments to fill three impending vacancies on the Parks and Recreation Commission or take other action.

BACKGROUND

The vacancies are due to the expiring terms of Commissioners Christine Ardito, Ian Milne, and Bob Palacio. The vacancies were publicized; notification letters were sent to past Commission applicants; and the Council interviewed three applicants on October 22, 2019. (One of these applicants subsequently withdrew her application.) Because Commissioner Palacio elected not to continue on the Commission, and because the Council has a policy to extend the deadline for applications any time an incumbent chooses not to reapply or otherwise withdraws from the process, the Council extended the deadline to receive applications to October 31, 2019. The City received eight new applications by the extended deadline and conducted interviews on November 14, 2019. The new applicants are: Shaeda Urbani, William Reagon, Fred Bauer, Andrea Pappajohn, Daniel Devoy, Craig Darling, James Haggarty, and Aric Agresi.

The eligible candidates for the three vacancies are: Christine Ardito, Ian Milne, Shaeda Urbani, William Reagon, Fred Bauer, Andrea Pappajohn, Daniel Devyo, Craig Darling, James Haggarty, and Aric Agresi.

The appointee terms will be for three years, ending on October 7, 2022.
