**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AMENDING THE
OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BURLINGAME FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 TO
REFLECT RECEIPT OF CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDS (CRF) IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$371,871**

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom proclaimed a State of Emergency as a result of the threat of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) in the State of California; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the City Council of the City of Burlingame declared its own local emergency relating to the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the State of California included in its fiscal year 2020-21 budget an allocation of monies from the Coronavirus Relief Funds to local governments, with \$371,871 allocated to the City of Burlingame; and

WHEREAS, the City of Burlingame has expended funds eligible for reimbursement under the applicable provisions of the federal CARES Act in responding to the public health emergency present by the Coronavirus Disease 2019.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME DOES
HEREBY RESOLVE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

The City of Burlingame's General Fund revenue budget for the 2020-21 fiscal year as adopted on June 15, 2020, is increased by the amount of \$371,871 in recognition of this reimbursement grant funding.
