Special District formed in 2003 to represent the interests of:


- 26 water suppliers in San Mateo, Santa Clara, and Alameda Counties

BAWSCA's Goal: A reliable supply of high-quality water at a fair price






San Francisco Hetch Hetchy Regional Water System
