

Cuernavaca Grass Off Leash Community Survey

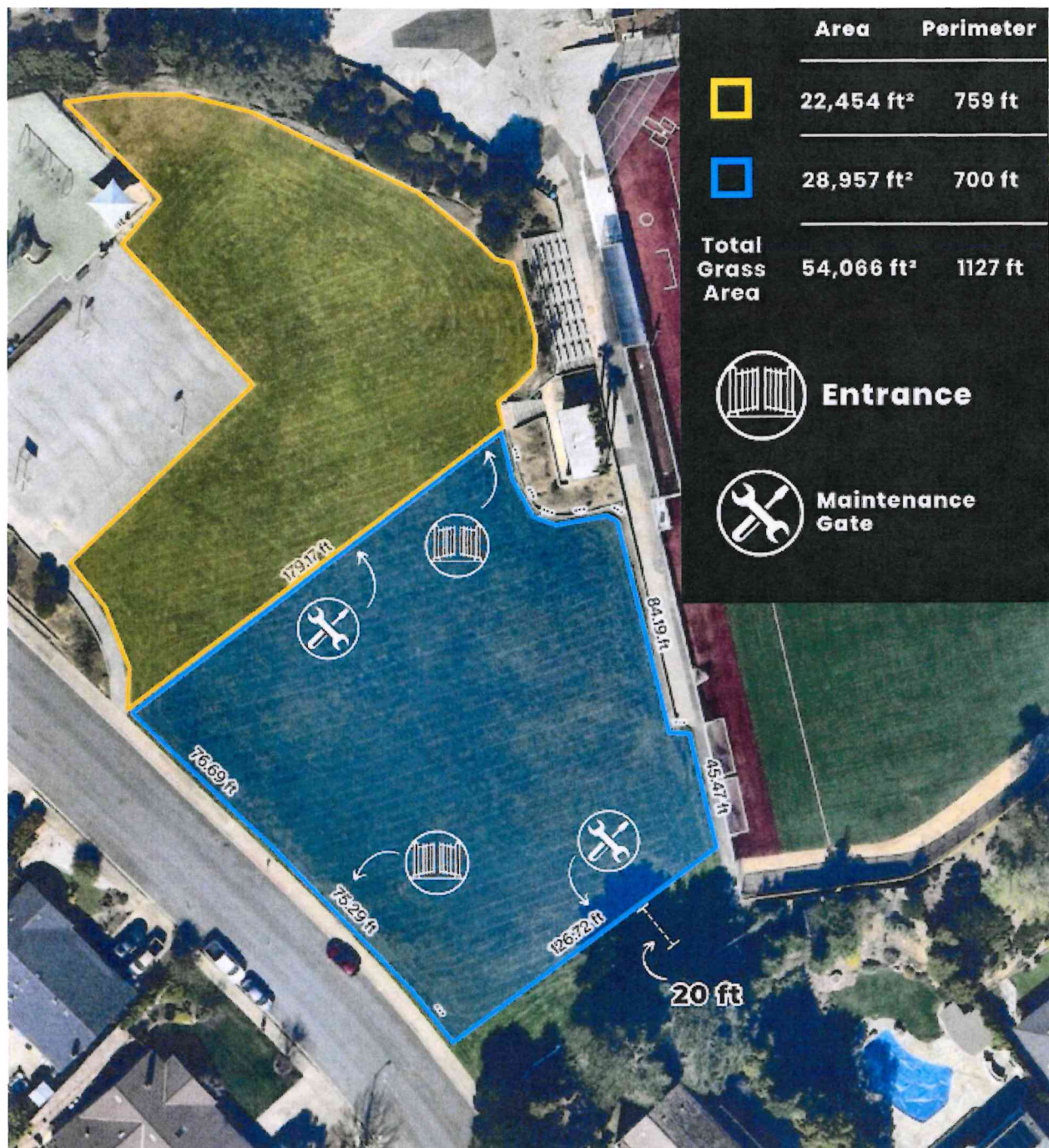
