

**RESOLUTION NO.**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AUTHORIZING  
THE MAYOR TO SEND A LETTER IN SUPPORT OF AB 1821 PENDING IN THE STATE  
LEGISLATURE**

**WHEREAS**, AB 1821 (Pacheco), California Public Records Act, seeks to shift agency response timelines from “calendar days” to “business days”; and

**WHEREAS**, current law requires the City to determine it has responsive records within ten days, with the ability to obtain a 14 day extension; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has seen an increase in public records requests in the past years, with 171 public records requests being completed in 85 days; and

**WHEREAS**, the California State Association of Counties is reporting a 73% increase in public records requests in the past five years, with over 90% diverting staff time away from core services; and

**WHEREAS**, AB 1821’s proposal to amend “calendar days” to “business days” will increase transparency and responsiveness by ensuring staff has time to review all potentially responsive records.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME DOES  
HEREBY RESOLVE THAT:**

The City Council authorizes the Mayor to send a letter, in the form attached, to the relevant State Legislators in support of AB 1821.
