**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AUTHORIZING
THE MAYOR TO SEND LETTERS IN SUPPORT OF THREE BILLS PENDING IN THE STATE
LEGISLATURE, AB 2111, AB 1761, AND SB 1138**

WHEREAS, Peninsula Clean Energy (PCE) has requested that all of its member cities as well as San Mateo County submit letters of support for three bills that are pending in the State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, AB 2111 (Papan), Modernizing Transmission Planning, is a PCE co-sponsored bill that seeks to improve California's electricity transmission planning framework by requiring the state to evaluate a broader set of plausible future scenarios and analyze the full system cost impacts of different combinations of electricity resources and transmission investments; and

WHEREAS, AB 1761 (Rogers), PCIA Transparency, would improve transparency in how the Power Charge Indifference Adjustment is calculated by requiring the Public Utilities Commission to disclose all underlying data used to calculate investor-owned utilities cost-recovery charges, giving Community Choice Aggregation programs like PCE and ratepayer advocates timely access to the information needed to assess forecasts, challenge assumptions, and protect customers from unjustified rate impacts; and

WHEREAS, SB 1138 (Padilla), Lowering Resource Adequacy Costs, would address inefficiencies in California's Resource Adequacy (RA) program by allowing capacity to be bought and sold in hourly increments, rather than only monthly, thereby reducing unnecessary over-procurement and lowering Resource Adequacy costs for ratepayers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME DOES
HEREBY RESOLVE THAT:**

The City Council authorizes the Mayor to send letters, in the form attached, to the relevant State Legislators in support of AB 2111, AB 1761, and SB 1138.
