Subject: Adoption of a Resolution Designating a Voting Delegate and an Alternate Voting Delegate for the 2026 League of California Cities' Annual Conference

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the attached Resolution to designate a voting delegate and an alternate voting delegate for the 2026 League of California Cities' Annual Conference.

BACKGROUND

The League of California Cities is holding its annual conference in Anaheim, CA, from Wednesday, September 23, 2026, through Friday, September 25, 2026. During the conference, the League holds its Annual Business Meeting (General Assembly) where members consider and take action on resolutions that establish League policy.

The League of California Cities informed the City that: "In order to vote at the Annual Business Meeting, your city council must designate a voting delegate. Your city may also appoint up to two alternate voting delegates, one of whom may vote in the event that the designated voting delegate is unable to serve in that capacity."

In accordance with the League of California Cities' requirements, the City must designate the voting delegate and alternates through Council action.

DISCUSSION

To ensure that the City's interests are recognized, staff recommends that the City Council adopt the attached Resolution, which designates Vice Mayor Andrea Pappajohn as the City's voting delegate and Councilmember Peter Stevenson as the alternate voting delegate.
