

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AND THE AFSCME LOCAL 829 ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT, THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AND THE AFSCME LOCAL 829 OPERATIONS UNIT, AND APPROVE THE AMENDED SALARY SCHEDULES FOR MERIT AND CASUAL CLASSIFICATIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Burlingame and the AFSCME Local 829 Administrative and Operations Units have met and conferred in good faith on the terms and conditions of employment as provided by State law; and

WHEREAS, the parties have reached agreements on changes to be made to the existing terms and conditions of employment in the former Memoranda of Understanding between the City and the bargaining units; and

WHEREAS, the proposed changes are fair and in the best interests of the public and the employees represented by the AFSCME Local 829 Administrative and Operations Units; and

WHEREAS, the City of Burlingame Salary Schedules have been amended in accordance with these agreement terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The changes in terms and conditions of employment for the employees represented by the AFSCME Local 829 Administrative Unit, as contained in the attached Memorandum of Understanding between the City and the AFSCME Local 829 Administrative Unit, is approved.
2. The changes in terms and conditions of employment for the employees represented by the AFSCME Local 829 Operations Unit, as contained in the attached Memorandum of Understanding between the City and the AFSCME Local 829 Operations Unit, is approved.
3. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute the Memoranda of Understanding as modified between the AFSCME Local 829 Administrative and Operations Units and the City of Burlingame.
4. The City of Burlingame Salary Schedules for Merit and Casual Classifications are approved as amended.
