**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME
APPROVING THE BURLINGAME SAFETY ACTION PLAN (VISION ZERO)**

WHEREAS, the City Council identified the development of a Vision Zero Goal/Policy and a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan (CSAP) as a top-tier priority among its citywide strategic initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the City of Burlingame received a federal Safe Streets and Roads for All grant to develop the Burlingame Safety Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Burlingame Safety Action Plan establishes the City's Vision Zero goal of eliminating traffic-related fatalities and serious injuries by 2040 and serves as the City's Vision Zero Action Plan, Comprehensive Safety Action Plan, and Local Road Safety Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Burlingame Safety Action Plan was developed using a comprehensive, data-informed process that included collision analysis, identification of priority safety projects, evaluation of safety strategies, and extensive public outreach and stakeholder engagement; and

WHEREAS, the City worked in partnership with Fehr & Peers, the Community Advisory Committee, the Vision Zero Task Force, the Traffic, Safety and Parking Commission, and the broader Burlingame community throughout development of the Burlingame Safety Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic, Safety and Parking Commission reviewed the Draft Burlingame Safety Action Plan on July 2, 2026, and unanimously recommended that the City Council adopt the plan; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Burlingame Safety Action Plan will provide a framework for future transportation safety investments, project development, implementation, and grant funding opportunities to improve safety for all roadway users.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME approves the **Comprehensive Safety Action Plan (CSAP) and appendices, as attached hereto.**
