A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A REVOCABLE LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN FRANCISCO PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE CALIFORNIA DRIVE CORRIDOR

WHEREAS, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission ("SFPUC") owns certain real property adjacent to California Drive within Burlingame; and

WHEREAS, the City of Burlingame has utilized portions of the SFPUC right-of-way for public roadway, parking, landscaping, water utility, transit, and municipal maintenance purposes pursuant to various agreements dating back to 1964; and

WHEREAS, the City and SFPUC have negotiated a Revocable License Agreement that supersedes previous agreements and establishes a comprehensive framework for the City's continued use, operation, and maintenance of public improvements within the SFPUC right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Revocable License Agreement also authorizes construction, operation, and maintenance of improvements associated with the California Drive Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement Project within the licensed area; and

WHEREAS, execution of the Revocable License Agreement will provide the necessary property rights for the City to continue maintaining existing public facilities and to complete the California Drive Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the proposed Revocable License Agreement and finds that entering into the agreement is in the best interests of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Burlingame, California, which finds and orders as follows:

1. The public interest and convenience require execution of the Revocable License Agreement.
2. The City Manager is authorized to sign said Agreement, in the form attached hereto, on behalf of the City of Burlingame.
3. The City Clerk is instructed to attest such signature.
