

RESOLUTION NO. ____-2026

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGAME AWARDING A \$300,000 CONTRACT TO PRECISIONWORKS LLC, DBA PRECISION CONCRETE CUTTING, FOR SIDEWALK ASSESSMENT, SIDEWALK DISPLACEMENT REPAIR, AND CURB RAMP ASSESSMENT SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, City staff recognizes the importance of maintaining and improving the City's sidewalks and non-compliant curb ramps to mitigate/remove sidewalk tripping hazards such as uplifted sidewalk and identify locations where ADA curb ramps improvements are needed; and

WHEREAS, PrecisionWorks, LLC, dba Precision Concrete Cutting (PCC), submitted a proposal to the City according to pricing in the Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) vendor agreement, TIPS RCSP 23060202, to assess and repair sidewalk displacements (horizontal concrete cutting/shaving) and provide curb ramp assessment services; and

WHEREAS, TIPS is a government purchasing cooperative that reduces the cost of procurement for educational and local government agencies, and the City's purchasing policy allows City staff to procure goods and specialized, professional, or recreational services from vendors through previously secured competitive pricing from government purchasing cooperatives; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City Council award the contract to PCC in the amount of \$300,000 for a two-year period ending on June 30, 2028, for sidewalk assessment, sidewalk displacement repair, and curb ramp assessment services; and

WHEREAS, there are adequate funds available in the Department's Operation and Maintenance Budget and Capital Improvement Project Budget to undertake the work for the current fiscal year, and funding for the following year of sidewalk assessment, sidewalk displacement repair, and curb ramp assessment services will be programmed into the future-year budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract for sidewalk assessment, sidewalk displacement repair, and curb ramp assessment with PrecisionWorks, LLC, dba Precision Concrete Cutting, in the form or substantially the same form as attached hereto, and take such actions to necessary in furtherance of this Resolution.
