



Do you live within a twenty-minute walk to Cuernavaca Park? 146 responses







- 2. I use this park semi regularly and though I don't need it to be fenced off, I like that this will allow for visits at times outside of the already set 6-7:30am allowance. If the fence gets denied, I'd ask to extend the current times or adjust sprinkler settings to no go off until after that time. I've had them go off while there and if they are on before I get there it leaves me with a muddy dog! Thank you
- 3. It is definitely necessary to add another dog designated area in Cuervanaca Park!! Given the newly built/added residential buildings in Burlingame, how much population this city adds and among them, how many would have dogs! We are in shortage of dog area. The early morning ones (6-7:30am), although those are nice to have, but not in heavy use at all. Most dog owners could not do that early due to many reasons family, kids, or preparing for work. And Ray park dog area, Adrain park are sooo small for bigger dogs, who actually are the primary users of dog playing area. All dog owners understand small breeds they do not need much space, even there is no dog park, small breeds can accommodate nicely. It is really the mid to big breeds who need dog parks. I go to Washington Outfield and Washington Park, and I feel there is a sufficient amount of fenced parks already available and within our city. We have been to Cuernavaca with our children and cannot imagine not having the large grassy area for them to do outdoor activities.
- 14. Thank you for offering this survey. A grassy, fenced dog option would be greatly appreciated!!
- 15. I live right across from the park. I'm completely against any fences being put up in the existing open space. The yellow safety top cap (I believe that's what it is) put up along the top of the fences along the perimeter of the baseball/soccer field is already an eyesore. Without it, the athletic field area tends to blend in with the natural surroundings of the open area. A temporary fence was put up for off-leash dog area a while ago while the athletic field was being renovated. It was ugly and an eyesore, and it prevented the use of the open space by others/non-dogs owners (kids, kite flyers, frisbee throwers, football tossers, sunbathers etc.). I bought my house 14 years ago and paid a premium at the time because of the open space across from my house. I don't want to see fences of any kind being up in the grassy open space.

- 18. Thank you so much for considering the fenced in option!
- 19. I would welcome any designated off-leash areas that are not dusty. There are lots of doodles with long hair in Burlingame including mine. Owners of these dogs tend to avoid dusty parks to keep the pets clean, which I believe is a big reason why off-leash dogs on Ray Park won't go away. My dogs love to run on grass, too. Washington Park is the only off-leash grass field in the city during the day whereas Cuernavaca used to be another choice. So I would be happy if Cuernavaca comes back assuming fencing the field makes it possible.. I don't care about the type of fence.

- 25. My dogs and I were daily users of the Cuernavaca outfield prior to installation of the artificial turf. We would appreciate an alternative fenced grass area with extended hours at Cuernavaca. We rarely use Skyline because my dogs tear up their paws when they run there and, as an amputee, I have difficulty navigating the terrain.

- 27. Dog park at Cuernavaca would be awesome! Many in the neighborhood used the baseball/soccer field before it was converted to turf. Cuernavaca grass area is relatively seldomly used otherwise

- 29. I would like to have an off leash dog are within walking distance of my house, so both the dog and I get exercise. All of the existing areas (including Cuernavaca) necessitate loading the dog in the car and driving. The fenced grass field at Ray Park has served as an informal and popular off leash area and community gathering site in the evenings for the Ray Park/Easton Addition area, albeit illicitly. Why not allow the use of this area, with appropriate restrictions ( such as no use during baseball season until the game or practice is over)? Outside of baseball season, when dogs are excluded the field sits unused. The current restriction is unreasonable.
- 30. The current hours at the Cuernavaca Grass area (6-7:30) is very limited. It's the only 'grass' area that we have around the neighborhood and I can't use it with my dog when it's more convenient. I don't see that area used much, at all, during the week and I don't see why we cannot have our dogs there. The other park (skyline) is full of fox-tails and mud (during raining season) and is not very 'nice' to the dogs or the owners.

Or having more covered / picnic bench areas for event reservations which could be a funding source for our parks.

- 46. Fence should match the other area fences and be an economical choice
- 47. This is a great idea. We used to have a wonderful community of dog owners at Cuernavaca park in the mornings before it became a turfed field and no dogs allowed. Fencing in the grass area will allow dog owners to use that field safely beyond 730am, and that grass area does not currently get much use anyway. Skyline park is close by but is full of stinging barbs and nettles and not well maintained. The additional cost of cleaning up Skyline park and maintaining it is probably going to be much more than putting up a simple fence in that grass area by Cuernavaca.

- 52. Can you remove the plastic tarp in the planter box between the basketball courts and tables. It creates microplastics and most weeds without tap roots just grow on top anyways
- 53. Please do not fence Cuernavaca park for dogs.

- 54. I STRONGLY disagree in Cuernavaca park becoming a fenced dog park! There are many dog parks in Burlingame. We need a park for children and adults to enjoy. This is absolutely ridiculous that you try every year to make this a dog park! I live directly across the street from where you want to put the fence and it's a major eye sore. I would have never purchased my home if I knew this was going to be a dog park!
- 55. Please do not fence in this lovely grass grassy area. There are plenty of areas nearby for people to walk their dogs.
- 56. Most enclosed dog parks in Burlingame are dusty and uncomfortable. Washington park field is the nicest but has limited hours and months. Closing Cuernavaca field removed a prime spot for dog owners in the hills, and having extremely limited hours off leash in an open area does not compensate. Dog parks are often closed same day and time windows leaving few good options. Cuernavaca park could again provide a safe grassy area for pets and kids to run freely without worry of the roads and cars. There should be multiple access gates since people enter from different parts (similar to Seal Point). The hours should include afternoons and weekends when there are not alternatives in Burlingame. The gate should be around the entire field, not just a small section of it—Ray Park, for example, is too small for dogs to play fetch. Thank you for helping all Burlingame residents with this initiative.
- 57. Area is a great space for kids and frisbees and soccer and football and taking away from that for dogs does not make sense.
- 58. owners should ensure they pick up after their dogs.
- 59. As a dog owner that has frequented Cuernavaca and Washington park for many years, I share the frustration of fellow dog owners with regards to the unrealistic off leash times you impose and we have no choice but to break your rules. Most of us are getting up and ready for work between 6:30 and 7:30 and then its off to work and we don't get home until the evening. Only then can our pets play, socialize and get the exercise they need. With regards to Skyline Park, it is poorly maintained, dusty, and hazardous with foxtails and burrs. Additionally it is dirty as owners don't clean up after their dogs. So I stopped going there. As for Bayside, it too is dusty and the

- smell of the water treatment plant next door is unbearable and unhealthy. So we don't go there either. But we would very much welcome a grassed, large fenced area such as Cuernavaca where we can take our dog after work during the week and during the day on weekends.
- 60. I think it is important to keep dogs within a fenced area away from other park goers.

- 68. The hours of 6-7:30 am are a joke. Coyotes are still out and about so suggesting to dog owners to let their animals run wild then is unsafe. cuernavaca park should be dog friendly at all times, a fence is a nice to have safety.

- 70. First, I want to say that as a dog owner, I appreciate the efforts you make to balance the needs of dog owners and non-dog owners. I know that people on both sides complain (a lot) and while I may not always agree with the rules, I recognize and know that you are trying to do the best for both sides. My only hesitation with making Cuernavaca fenced is that when there is more access it often brings in dog owners from outside Burlingame and that has caused issues at other dog parks. What I appreciate about Ray Dog Park (which is close to my house) is that it's the same neighborhood dogs at the park, so you know the dogs and owners. I also hope that you do consider any additional feedback from the neighbors in that area. There has been quite a bit of controversy over Ray Park from one neighbor in particular who felt their opinions about the park were not recognized.
- 71. I have visited Cuernavaca Park and have observed dog droppings in the grassy area, which is a concern.
- 72. Access to a grassy field that is protected by fencing and legitimately for doggies again would improve the quality of our outings. We loved the people and environment at Cuernavaca and was so sad when it closed for the turf. Thank you for considerations.
- 73. It only takes a few months of consistent enforcement with real financial penalties to change behavior. Once dog owners understand that this is a law with financial consequences, they will comply—just as people do with handicap parking. No amount of patrols or verbal warnings will stop the ongoing behavior of dog owners unleashing their pets in non-dog areas, especially at Ray Park. The only effective solution is a clear penalty structure that is enforced.

- 74. Please extend the dog off leash hours for Cuernavaca grass area given the turf is now designed for kids to play in. Best to have afternoon hours too and give busy family a chance to take their fur babies out
- 75. Ray Park Dog area really needs some pea gravel or crushed granite just putting ground up tree debris is not good for the dogs.
- 76. I love this idea! A grass option is exactly what the city needs to allow for a clean space for our dogs.
- 77. When will long fence at skyline park be removed. The park is half its original size and creates stress for dogs that need more space.
- 78. No problem with dogs off leash but don't fence the area it'll block the humans
- 79. Grass would be great! The dust and debris at Ray park is nasty.
- 80. my dog isn't up before 8am so having something off leash only until 7:30am is less than useful. real grass is the best surface: tan bark is awful for dog's paws.

- 83. I am not a dog owner, but a pet care provider. This is a wonderful spot. A fence would make it ideal for local dogs.
- 84. We loved Cuernavaca when it was open for dogs. It was a true community of dog owners that we saw every day. Having that community back would be amazing.
- 85. No preference for fence type but couldn't bypass it. I dogsit a dog in Burlingame Hills and do not have a car. Always looking for walking distance options to take her. For myself this is ideal but it does seem many Burlingame residents prefer lower Burlingame, i.e. proximity to Burlingame Ave. Bayside Dog Exercise Park I will not go to due to smell and nothing attractive about it. I do like Skyline Dog Park but that newly built divided fence needs to go! I think most people would agree, take down

- the divider fence and instead create small dog area. I don't dogsit small dog but that's the feedback I'm hearing.
- 86. Recently visited a dog park in Corte Madera and they had a concrete pad outside the dog area with a possibility to clean off the dog with a short hose, attached to the drink and water stations we already have, but with an extra hose attachment and button on the side. Really beneficial when the canines have gotten rambunctious.
- 87. I hope the hours can be prolonged at this park at more reasonable times this is the only space in the surrounding neighborhoods where dogs can play (the kids have the playground and the field) and I think it's a fair ask given the # of dogs and dog owners that go here. So in short, in order for the rules to be effective, they need to be more reasonable, 6-7:30am is not very doable for many families. Thank you for your consideration.

- 91. I admire your efforts to provide more dog parks with grass, however, this particular site is not good with the slope. There's potential for a lot of injuries (torn ligaments), especially if the ground is wet. I saw more than a few dogs slide down that slope chasing others when it was temporarily fenced off years back.
- 92. I go to Cuernavaca from time to time (not in the am), but it's too far uphill to walk to regularly. Nevertheless, I don't see an issue there that requires a fence. Also, a fence would shrink the area that dogs can run in, and as a result many dog owners wouldn't use it (see Ray Park dog park). The whole point of taking your dog to the dog park is to let them run full speed over distance (chasing a dog or a ball) until they are exhausted. Shrinking the area means they won't get that exercise.
- 93. Have always enjoyed Cuernavaca park for the green space and torn on the decision to turf the field but understand the reasons. I would want to maintain the attractiveness of the park and space I would worry about the grass becoming a dirt

- patch or muddy mess with a fenced dog area. I also think it may attract more people and dogs.
- 94. It was incredibly disappointing to see the field changes at Cuervavaca park take place, push out the dog owners and to see the field rarely used. It felt like a huge waste of money and was really sad for the residents. Moving forward, this shouldn't have even been a question posed to residents, as this should have already been done, and the hours need to be sun up to sun down. Skyline dog park is not only inaccessible for those with mobility issues, there is no grass and hardly any shade or safe parking. I have stopped using ANY dog parks in Burlingame for these reasons and instead go to San Mateo. I really hope to see these changes made. When taking away a resource for residents, you shouldn't need a survey to ask if they should replace the same resource.

You've lost control. Yet you want more dog parks for people to abuse them. Enforce the rules!
